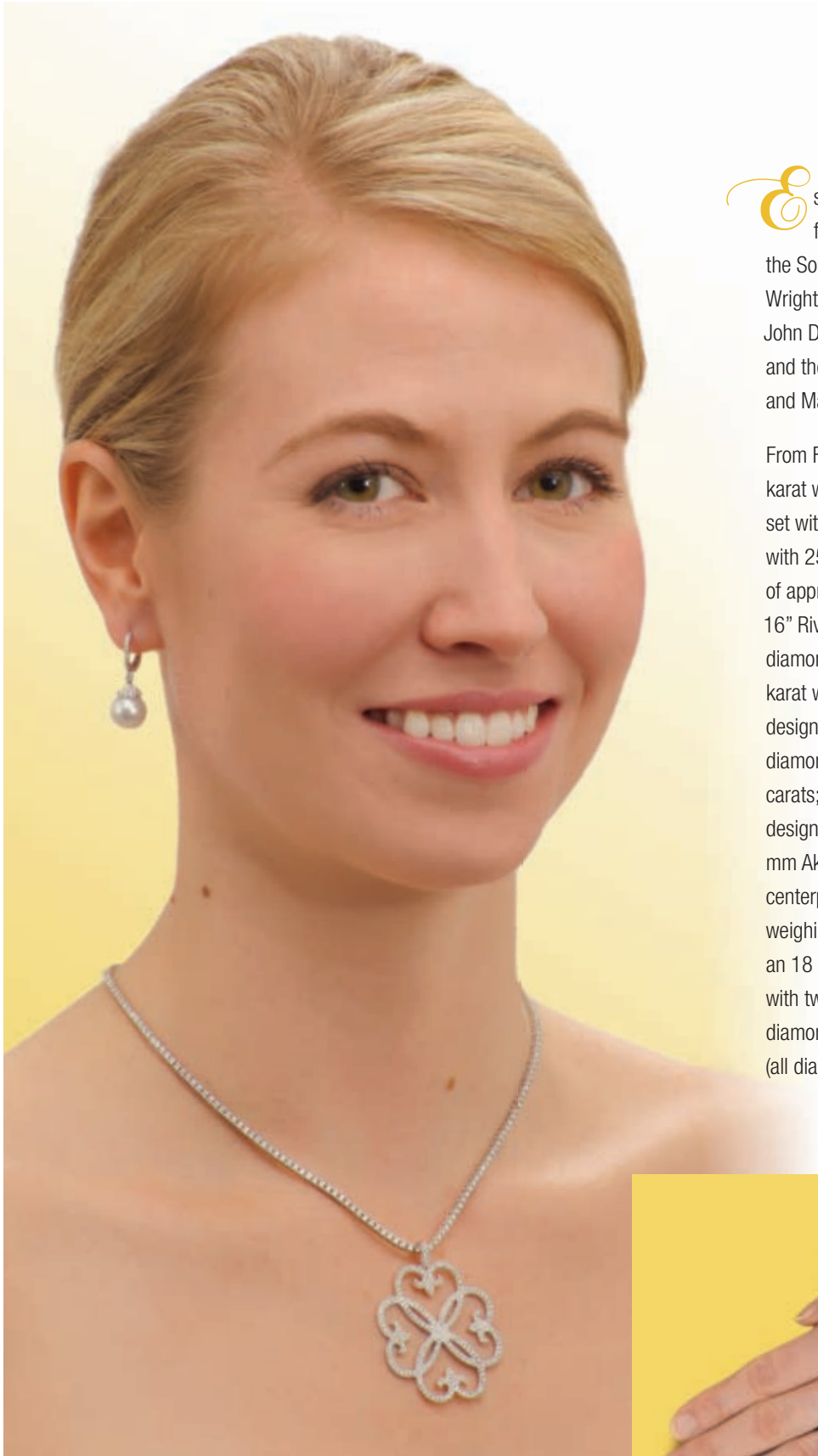

From Fischer Evans Jewelers, Esmé is wearing 18 karat white gold European drop pierced earrings, each set with one 10 mm South Sea quality gem accented with 25 round brilliant cut diamonds weighing a total of approximately .40 carats; one 14 karat white gold 16" Riviera necklace set with 264 round brilliant diamonds weighing a total of 6.90 carats; one 18 karat white gold shamrock and fleur-de-lis pendant designed by Leslie Greene, paved with 212 full cut diamonds weighing a total of approximately 1.10 carats; a ladies 7 strand cultured pearl bracelet designed by Rudolf Friedman, consisting of 364 - 3.0 mm Akoya pearls with an elegant rectangular floral centerpiece set with 69 round brilliant diamonds weighing a total of approximately .75 carats; and an 18 karat white gold Halo design engagement ring with two marquise diamond accents and 98 pave diamonds weighing a total of .75 carats.
